Eligibility

All fine art media are accepted, including painting, drawing, photography, sculpture, fiber, glass, graphics, mixed media, digital/video media, ceramics, and jewelry. All work must be original and completed within the past two years. Ineligible work includes class work or work previously exhibited by South Shore Arts. All work must be suitable for display. Sculpture must have bases. Graphic work must be matted, backed, protected by glass or (preferable) Plexiglas and framed. Paintings can be framed or unframed. All work that will hang on the wall **MUST BE FITTED WITH WIRE or D-RINGS. Sawtooth-type hanging devices will not be accepted.** Work must not weigh more than 150 pounds. Shipped work must conform to UPS regulations.

Entry Qualifications

The artist must be 18 years or older. He/She must reside or have been born in the state of Indiana; or be a member of South Shore Arts; or reside or work in Cook County, Illinois.

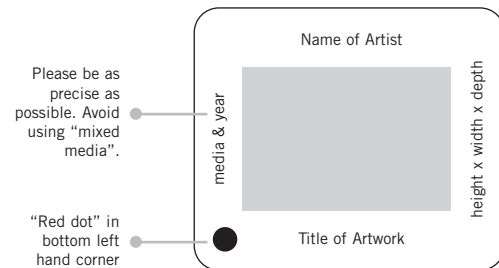
How to Submit Your Work

Artists may send slides or digital images on a disk. Do not send slides in glass or extra heavy mountings. Please do not submit iPod Flash discs. Digital images must be saved at a resolution of 300dpi, no smaller than 4 inches in either direction and saved as .jpg files. Name files with the first 6 letters of your last name, your first initial and the number of entry, 1, 2, 3, etc.

Example: smithb1.jpg (.jpg files only)

You may submit a maximum of 3 images if you are submitting two-dimensional work, i.e., drawings, paintings, prints; You may submit 9 images, one full-view and up to 2 details of each entry, **IF** you are submitting three-dimensional work, i.e., reliefs, sculptures, ceramics. Digital images should be accompanied by a separate inventory sheet or labeled directly on the disk. Please do not include label information on the image.

For labeling slides, please refer to the example shown below.



Entries without required images will be rejected. Label each slide with the information shown. Please Note: Slides and disks of accepted work will be kept in South Shore Arts archives, after the exhibition.

Entry Fee

\$20 for current members or \$25 for non-member artist allows for two (2) entries. Both members and non-members may add \$5 to submit a third entry. Please make checks payable to *South Shore Arts*. The fee must accompany the (1) entry form, (2) slides or disk, (3) a self-addressed stamped envelope for the purpose of returning artist's slides or disk and sending acceptance/declined notification. These entry requirements must be in the office of South Shore Arts by 5:00 pm, Friday, December 3, 2010. Entry fee is non-refundable.

Notification

Notification of accepted/declined artwork will take place following the jurying process. The notification card will be mailed from the office of South Shore Arts no later than December 17, 2010.

Delivery of Accepted Work

Accepted artwork can be shipped or delivered in person. ALL artwork must be at South Shore Arts no later than December 28, 2010. If shipping your artwork, please clearly address it to: Mary McClelland, Salon Show Entry, South Shore Arts, 1040 Ridge Road, Munster, IN 46321.

All shipped entries will be returned following the exhibit.

Please note: Any work left seven days after the close of the exhibit is subject to a fine of \$5.00 per day. Any artwork left over 30 days becomes the property of South Shore Arts.

Sales

South Shore Arts receives 35% of sale proceeds. Indiana sales tax is applicable. Work in the show will be listed for sale unless otherwise instructed. All sold work must remain on view for the duration of the exhibition. A payment check to the artist will be issued within 30 days of the exhibit's close.

South Shore Arts reserves the right to rejury or reject any work not meeting the requirements, misrepresented in the slides, or work that is too fragile for exhibition. By submitting your work, paying the entry fee and providing your signature, the artist asserts that he/she has read and complied with the rules of eligibility.

The Juror:

Lanny Silverman has over 30 years experience curating and promoting contemporary and avant garde art forms from our own and other cultures.

As Curator of Exhibitions for the Chicago Department of Cultural Affairs at the Chicago Cultural Center since March, 1990, Lanny Silverman has curated over 90 exhibitions, most notably *Sowers of Myth* (1991); *Michiko Itatani: Paintings Since 1984* (1992); *The Nature of the Machine* (1993); *ConTextual: Art & Text In Chicago* (2001); *Leon Golub: Works Since 1947* (2003); *Nick Cave: Soundsuits* (2006); *Karl Wirsum: Winsome Works(some)* (2007); *William Conger: Paintings 1958-2008* (2009); and *Diane Simpson: Sculpture + Drawings, 1978-2009* (2010).

The juror will refrain from making any decision, whether in the jurying process or in judging for awards, that would financially benefit him/her at any time during the course of the exhibition.
